The Millbrook BIA is initiating a local "Stop Gap Project Program." Stop Gap Ramps are temporary accessibility aids that can be set out and removed from store front doorways. People with walkers, wheelchairs, cane and strollers will enter your store with greater ease.

The Millbrook BIA has set aside funds to help our BIA Members offset the costs of these ramps. Recognizing that each store front is unique, our project coordinator will take measurements and provide you with a quote. The Millbrook BIA will reimburse up to 50% of the cost of the ramp once it is installed.

We are so excited to be one of the first communities in the Peterborough and the Kawarthas to have accessibility ramps. Our goal is to have as many ramps as we can in place by this summer. It is with pride that our community is recognized as an age and accessibility friendly community. The ramp will also help your business comply with The Accessibilities for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) which will come into effect in the near future.
