COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility Update

Peterborough Public Health has received an initial shipment of COVID-19 Moderna XBB.1.5 vaccine. We are underway on vaccinating residents in the first two eligibility groups and have clinics ready for all residents ages 6 months and older. Priority for appointments will be given to those in eligibility groups 1 and 2.

Influenza vaccines are anticipated to be available later in October. Communication will go out when they are available.

- 3. Primary Healthcare provider
 - Some health care providers are administering COVID-19 vaccines for their patients

Who is eligible:

First eligible group: High Priority

If you have NOT received a COVID-19 vaccine within the last 6 months AND fit into one of the following categories

- Hospitalized individuals and hospital staff
- Long-Term Care Home and Elder Care Lodge residents, staff, and caregivers

Second group: High Priority

If you have NOT received a COVID-19 vaccine within the last 6 months AND fit into one of the following categories

- Individuals at high-risk for influenza and/or COVID-19 related complications or hospitalization:
 - Residents and staff of congregate living settings (e.g., chronic care facilities, retirement homes)
 - Pregnant individuals
 - o Individuals ≥ 65 years of age
 - All children 6 months to 4 years of age [influenza risk]

- Individuals who are from a First Nation, Inuit or Métis community, and/or who self-identify as First Nation, Inuit, or Métis, and their household members
- Individuals 6 months of age and older with underlying health conditions per NACI (Influenza & COVID-19)
- Members of racialized and other equity deserving communities
- Health care workers and first responders

Final eligible group: Lower Priority

If you have NOT received a COVID-19 vaccine within the last 6 months AND fit into one of the following categories

• Administration for the general public will begin as soon as supply permits.
