**Public Service Announcement: Update**

**Millbrook Water Main Break – Air in Your Water System**

Township of Cavan Monaghan has been working to restore full water services to residents on the Millbrook Municipal Water System as quickly as possible.

There is water flowing through the systems however it continues to be regarded as untreated and unsafe for consumption. Due to the multiple disruptions in the system, air may be present within the pipes of your home. We recommend residents open several taps within their homes to release air. You may notice rumbling noises coming from the faucets and discolouration of the water.

A Boil Water Order is still in effect for the Village of Millbrook and will remain in effect until Monday. Water coming from the taps is currently considered untreated and unsafe for uses outside of flushing toilets. We are fully engaged with Haliburton and Kawartha Pine Ridge District Health Unit to meet quality compliance standards.

The water that is flowing our system must continue to be regarded as untreated and unsafe for consumption. Due to the multiple disruptions in the system, it could be expected that there is air within the pipes and system of your home. We can now recommend that residents open several taps within their home to attempt to release this air that can cause noisy vibrations in pipes and loud sputtering from taps.

The water may also be discoloured due to its untreated nature and should continue to be used for only essential purposes.
