PUG Services Corp. aims to adhere to the operational and compliance limits set out in the Permit and Licence however, certain operational circumstances may cause results to be temporarily outside of the limits. This is as a result of pump start ups, power outages, generator tests, fire hydrant flushing, calibration and alarm verification and are a normal part of operations. This is acceptable as per paragraph 3.4 of the Permit to Take Water 7704-AW7HJF.
